

IBB Programme

It is strongly recommended to follow the IBB Recommended Study Plan (available [here](#)).

Compulsory Courses (oP group, 120 ECTS for the whole study period)

1. oP for the students in the FIRST year of their study

1st semester:

- 3BE112 – Mathematics for Economists I (usually available in both WS as well as SS)
- 4IT152 – Informatics
- 5EN152 – Basic Microeconomics (usually available in both WS as well as SS)
- 33F151 – Marketing and Business Policy
- 2ZP151 – Sustainable Development and Environment

2nd semester:

- 2PR151 – Introduction to Law
- 5EN153 – Basic Macroeconomics (usually available in both WS as well as SS)
- 2OP222 – Principles of Management
- 4ST601 – Statistics (usually available in both WS as well as SS)
 - o it is recommended not to take Statistics unless you have already passed Mathematics (3BE112)
- 2SE152 – Geography of the World Economy

2. oP courses for the students in the SECOND year of their study

3rd semester:

- 2M0252 – Doing Business in Globalized Environment
- 2M0352 – International Business Operations
- 1FU251 – Accounting I (usually available in both WS as well as SS)

4th semester:

- 2OP251 – Retail Management
- 1FP251 – Corporate Finance
- 2SE251 – International Economics
- 11F251 – Financial Theory, Policy and Institutions

3. oP courses for the students in the THIRD year of their study

5th semester:

- 2OP352 – Retail Marketing
- 2F300 – Bachelor's Thesis Seminar (the only course for which a student can be enrolled while on Erasmus; have to be taken at least one semester before the last semester)
- 2SE252 – World Economy (can be taken after passing 2SE251!)

6th semester:

- 2M0351 – International Trade (can be taken only after passing 2SE251!)

Compulsory Language Course (oJP group, 18 ECTS for the whole study period):

Every language course is for 3 ECTS. Winter semesters are ideal for taking up a new language since the beginner classes are available only in WS.

Czech language (lectures based on English)

Courses **available ONLY in Winter Semester (WS):**

- 2AJ151 Czech for Foreigners 1(A1)
- 2AJ251 Czech for Foreigners 3(A2)
- 2AJ355 Czech for International Business 1 (B1)

Courses **available ONLY in Summer Semester (SS)**

- 2AJ152 Czech for Foreigners 2 (A1) - follows the course 2AJ151
- 2AJ252 Czech for Foreigners 4 (A2) - follows the course 2AJ251
- 2AJ356 Czech for International Business 2 - follows the course 2AJ355

Other foreign language course (lectures based on ENGLISH)

Strongly recommended for foreign students without very good knowledge of CZECH.

Courses **available ONLY in WS:**

- 2R0121 – Basic French for Economists I (A0/A1)
- 2R0123 – Lower Intermediate French for Economists 1 (A1/A2)
- 2R0181 – Basic Spanish for Economists I (A0/A1)
- 2R0183 – Lower Intermediate Spanish for Economists 1 (A1/A2)
- 2NJ151 – Basic German for Economists 1 (A1)
- 2NJ153 – Lower intermediate German for Economists 1 (A2)

Courses **available ONLY in SS:**

- 2R0122 – Basic French for Economists II (A1)
- 2R0124 – Lower Intermediate French for Economists 2 (A2)
- 2R0182 – Basic Spanish for Economists II (A1)
- 2R0184 – Lower Intermediate Spanish for Economists 2 (A2)
- 2NJ152 – Basic German for Economists 2 (A1/A2)
- 2NJ154 – Lower intermediate German for Economists 2 (A2)

Courses **available in WS as well as SS**

- 2AJ171 – Chinese - Elementary Course A for IBB (A1)
- 2AJ172 – Chinese - Elementary Course B for IBB (A1)
 - o These two cannot be taken as oJP but only as optional course – group oV2

ATTENTION!

Other than the language courses on the list above are based on the Czech language. So, please, do not register for other language courses than these if you do not have a very good knowledge of Czech.

Also, language courses of higher level of proficiency are based on Czech.

Optional Courses (oV and oV2 group)

One or even more optional courses are recommended to all IBB students, depending on their total number of registered credits – around 30 credits per semester is optimal. Students in the fifth, or higher, semester should check how many credits they still need to pass in each group. There are 3 types of optional courses:

1. oV courses
2. oV2 courses
3. Intensive courses (can belong to the group oV, oV2, or both – so, you can choose)

1. oV courses (Faculty level; in total you need to achieve 21 ECTS for oV)

Optional courses offered at the Faculty level (oV), including language certificates (not all of them are necessarily available in the WS/SS – you need to check in InSIS - Course catalogue).

2. oV2 courses (University level; in total you need to achieve 15 ECTS for oV2)

Within this group of optional courses (oV2) IBB students can register even a foreign language course (still **remember that classes will be most likely based on Czech**, so if you do not have a very good knowledge of the Czech language, do not take these language courses) and other courses offered by all faculties of the University. Not all of them are necessarily available in the WS /SS – you need to check in InSIS - Course catalogue.

3. oV and oV2 in a form of INTENSIVE COURSE

Students can also choose from the list of intensive courses below. The list is always sent by the programme coordinator at the beginning of course registration period. They are taught by visiting professors. The courses are usually held 3 days in a row.

Sport Course (cTVS)

Please, note that sport courses are NOT compulsory within the IBB study plan. However, IBB students can register sport courses offered by the University if interested (as optional courses). You will not receive credits for it. The list of all courses is available at the website ctvs.vse.cz (section Degree students) or in InSIS/Study Plans.
